Delegates: “We will proclaim His peace to those near and far.”

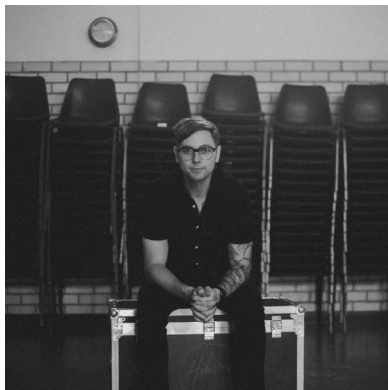
Leader: “Through Him we have access to the Father by one Spirit.”
